B₂B

VE companies use the virtual marketplace to procure the services and products necessary to operate their businesses.

B-to-B Examples: Leases, utilities, insurance, office furniture and equipment, advertising, design services, professional services.

B₂C

Students model entry-level adults with responsibilities of maintaining a personal budget, purchasing goods and services through the virtual marketplace.

B-to-C Examples: Food, clothing, automobile leasing, apartment leasing, entertainment, personal utilities/services, travel, and more

B2G (Guest)

Guest shoppers at trade shows receive credit cards to make purchases at VE company booths. The cards have a limit of \$5,000 per transaction per booth.

Firms may also enter into contracts with "Non-VE" entities to subsidize employee payroll expenses.
